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Imee Su Martinez is a Professor of the Institute of Chemistry University of the Philippines-Diliman. Her research interest is surface chemistry, characterizing molecules at interfaces using surface-specific techniques. She served as the Director of OIL System, and the AVP for Internationalization under the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs from 2021 to 2024.
